The regular council meeting was held on the 14th March 2017, at the Luskville community centre.

RPGL's (municipal lawyers) offer for legal services was accepted and their contract renewed for 2017 and 2018 (No cost disclosed).

Amounts transferred from the non-appropriated surplus to specific appropriated surplus funds, for work not carried out in 2016, but expected in 2017:

\$223,500 for Public Works for rehabilitation of some roads.

\$25,000 for washrooms at the Luskville Community centre.

\$25,000 for roof repairs at the Town hall.

\$20,000 for roof repairs at the Luskville library

\$11,000 for the gate on Terry Fox road.

## A summary of expenses approved:

Invoices amounting to \$136,025 and fixed and pre-approved expenses of \$792,845, for January and February, and incurred expenses for March of \$139,788.

Up to \$37,500 to rehabilitate the Luskville Recreation Park, (up to 66% to be funded by Nouveau fond Chantiers program (FPC)).

A total of \$6,960 for use of the Shawville Arena skating rink (figure skating and minor hockey).

\$2000 per year for 5 years, to the Quyon Family Centre for accommodating the Grenier des Collines sharing store.

\$1,063 as an additional contribution to OMH (social housing), being 10% of the corrected amount for 2015.

A total of \$35,695 to the following organizations:

Canada Day Committee, \$5,000

Groupe Action Jeunesse, \$6,000

Get Art Project (GAP), \$2,500

Parents de la Municipalité de Pontiac 0-5, \$3,350

Quyon Family Centre, \$2,000

Centre Kogaluk, \$3,885

Quyon Golden Age Club, \$1,000

Quyon Sports and Recreation Association, \$4,000

Table Autonome des Aînés des Collines, \$1,000.
