

# Pontiac Council - snow contract and ball-park lighting

A special meeting of Pontiac municipal council was held on Sunday 9 August 2020 at 6 pm, at the Luskville community centre, observing physical distancing and mask wearing. Councillors McKay, Barber and Patry, Mayor Joanne Labadie and Director general Pierre Said took part. The next regular meeting is on August 25.

The main purpose of the meeting was to pass a resolution to ask for tenders for snow removal for the Luskville area from Tremblay/Crégheur to Kennedy, (sector F). The contract is expected to be above \$100,000 so would be put on Québec's electronic tendering system, [seao.ca](http://seao.ca), immediately and the contract awarded at the regular meeting, following receipt of bids.

Another item was to award a contract for supplying lighting for the Luskville recreational park. The lowest bid was from Lumens LED Inc for \$37,306. Two more steps are required: to acquire posts for the lights, and to have them installed by an electrician. The project will be paid by the Blue Jays fund and the Québec Ministry of Education.
